Bst Practice II -

### Titel of of the practice:-

"Students' visit to Legislature."

#### Objectives:-

This best practice aims to obtain political awareness in the students. In this regards following are the objective –

- 1. To know the duty of people representative
- 2. To know the functioning of the government
- 3. To know the functioning of the legislative process.
- 4. To know how to pass the bills in vidhansabha i.e. legislative assembly and vidhanparishad i.e. legislative council
- 5. To know the constitutional instruments use by the MLAS and MLCs
- 6. To know the function and role of the oppostion members
- To make them aware how people's representative act in the house to protect citizen's right and to solve people's problems.

#### The Context:-

As per Nagpur agreement at the time of formation of integrated Maharashtra, decision was taken that, the winter session of Maharashtra Legislature should held at Nagpur since then every year in the month of December winter session of Maharashtra Legislature held at Nagpur as there is huge building of a Legislature and other infrastructure. So the students can visit the Legislature in the month of December.

#### The Practice:-

The head of the Political Science department organizes this practice since last 20 years. Every year professor prepared a list of B.A. 1st year, B.A. 2nd year and B.A. 3rd year. While preparing the list the selection is done on the basis of their performance in the class because we cannot allow all the students to visit Legislature. The college send the list of students to the Legislature. The Legislature send a letter to the college to convey particular date on which student can visit to Legislature. Legislature allowed the students only for one hour to visit Legislative assembly and one hour for Legislative council. The authorities of the Legislature give the entry passes on same day on which the date is confirm. The organizing faculties have to collect the entry passes before one hour on sheduled date. After getting the pass all the students are allow to get inside the Legislature through security check. The students seat for one hour in legislative assembly and legislative council respectively. They observe the functioning and proceeding of the house which they learn theoretically. With this activity the students can understand the functioning of the legislature, Government, Roll of MLA, MLC and opposition party. They can develop their knowledge regarding political process, social problems and its consequences in future. With this knowledge the students can perform efficiently in any sector while performing in any responsible position. This activity is highly helpful to them in future performance. Some students can get inspiration from politicians and they also take decision to join politics and contest the Election. This activity helps them to develop their personality. Thus this is one of the unique activities of the college, which develop overall personality of those who participate in the activity.

#### Evidence of Success:-

The evidences of success of this activity is as under-

- 1. Correspondence letter to the Legislature with the students list
- 2. Approval letter of principal secretory of Maharashtra Legislature.
- 3. Students got prominent position in the society
- 4. Some students become politicians

#### Problems encountered and Resources required -

Main Problems is the house can be adjourned some time on any burning issue or any disputed matter. At that time the students could not see the house proceeding and functioning of government, opposition and the role of representative. Another problem is that the security force is deploying with the students full time. They remained attend with the students at ouside the gate to which the student entered in the house. They sometime take out the students from house before time and disturb them to seat and observe the house functioning. This found many time.

In this process, winter legislative session period passed, so it is not held in the Nagpur and student Legislative visit could not be organised. In the year 2020 and 2021 due to covid-19 pandemic, Legislative winter session not held in Nagpur. In 2022 winter session held in Nagpur, but from November 2021 the head of the department of Political Science became officiating Principal. So he holds Administrative responsibility. That's why he could not be able to organise Legislative student visit activity. In the next session, responsibility of this activity will be given to other faculty member and efforts will be taken to continue this activity.

Hence 2018 Assembly visit documents are submitting which cover in the Assessment period. Previous documents are available in the department file.
